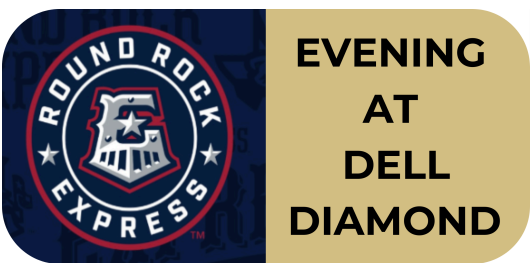
### Silent Auction | Monday, June 23

### 89th Legislative Session

A special thank you to our members, Superintendents Dr. Brandon Enos (Cushing ISD), Dr. Brad Owen (Burkburnett ISD), and Mr. Kevin McCasland (Iowa Park CISD), for their tireless advocacy on behalf of rural schools during this legislative session.

These gentlemen started their day at the Capitol around 7:30am on April 29 to testify on HB 4—an Accountability Revision bill that would mark a historic shift by eliminating the STAAR test. After waiting over 18 hours to speak, they finally testified around 2am on April 30. TREA is proud to have such dedicated leaders working on behalf of our members.

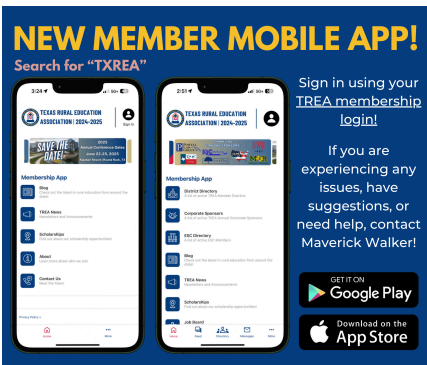
