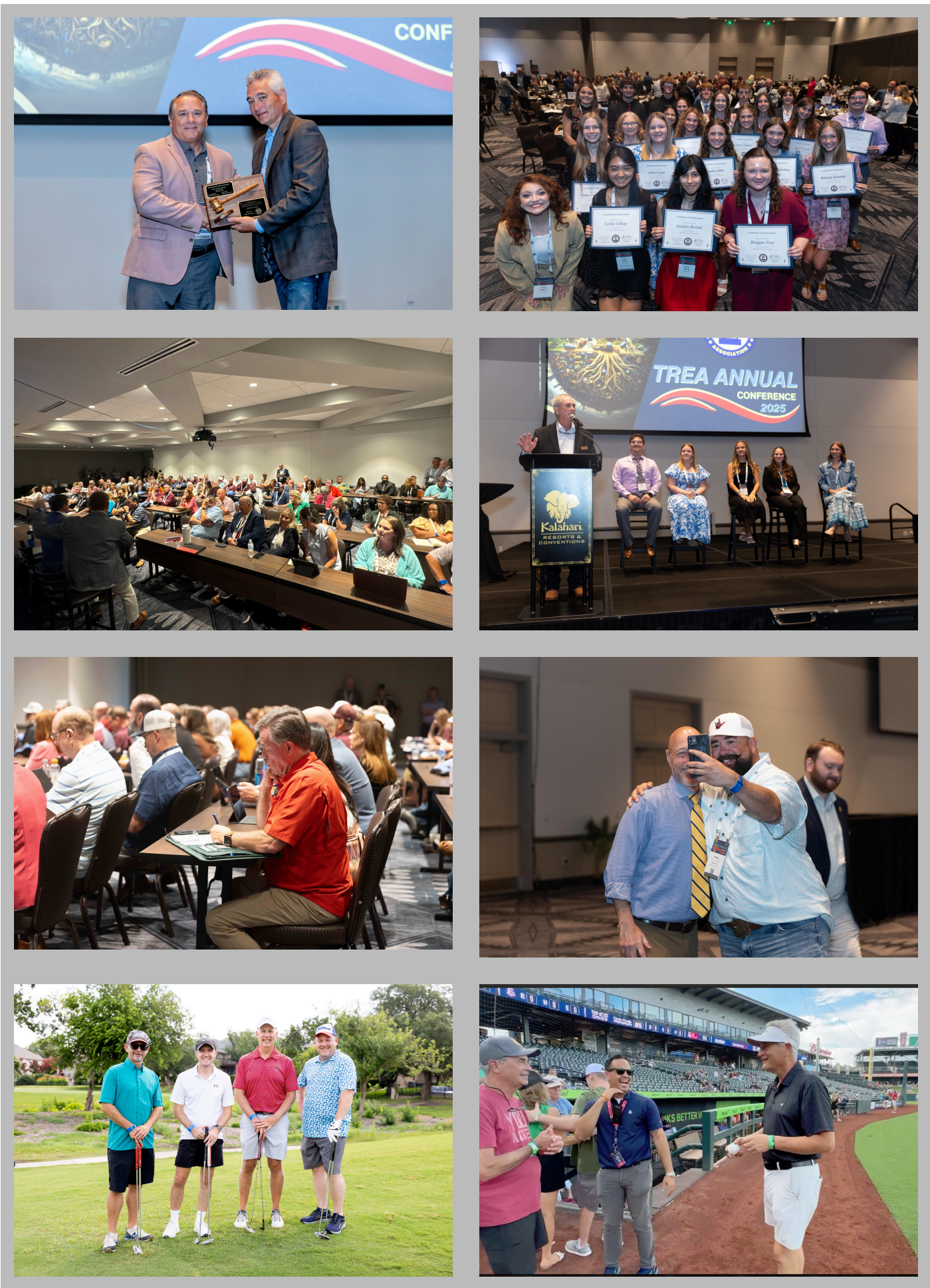


Conference Highlights!

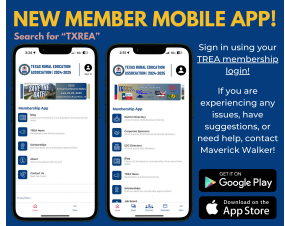
